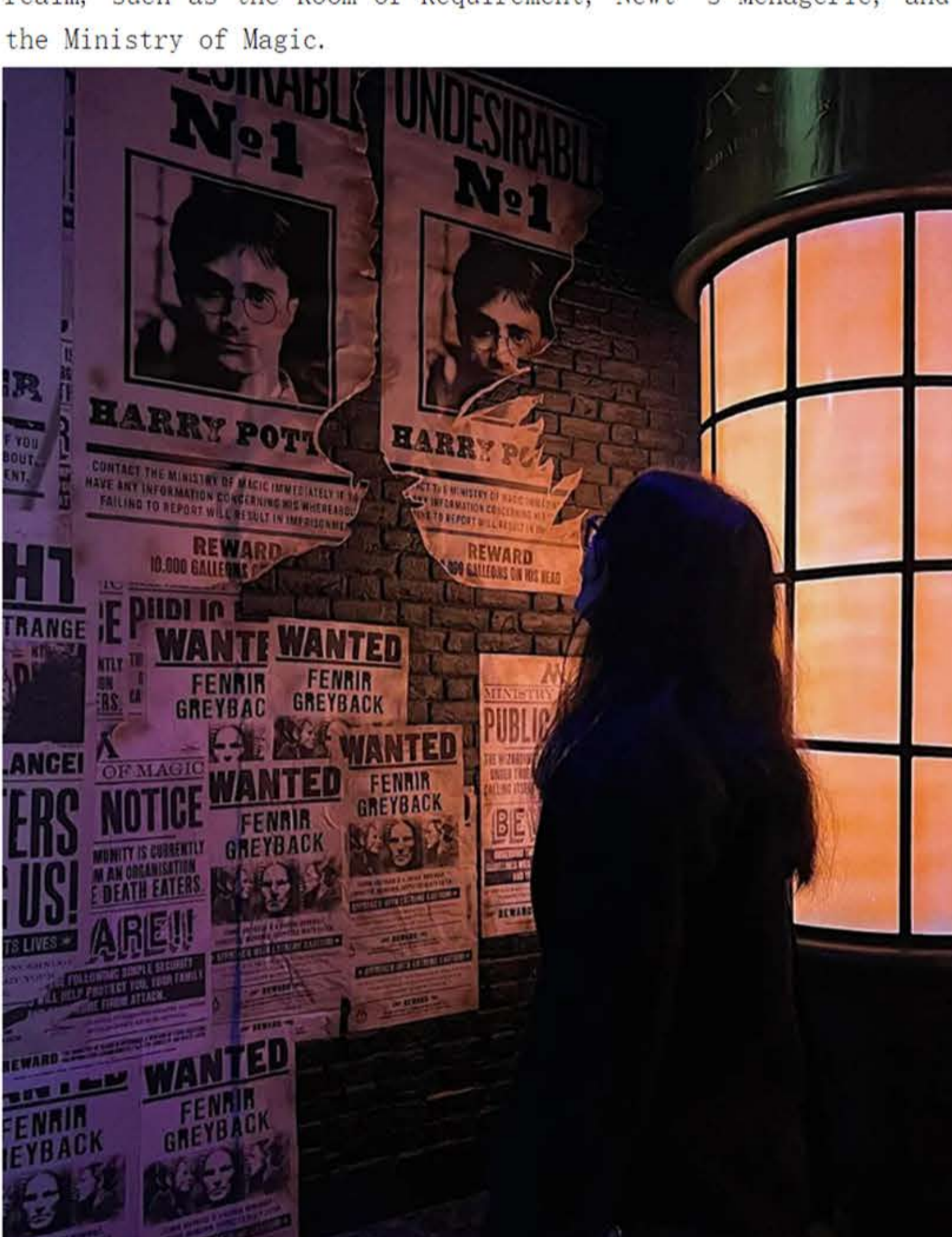
What to expect at the upcoming Harry Potter exhibition in Singapore?

When is it launching?

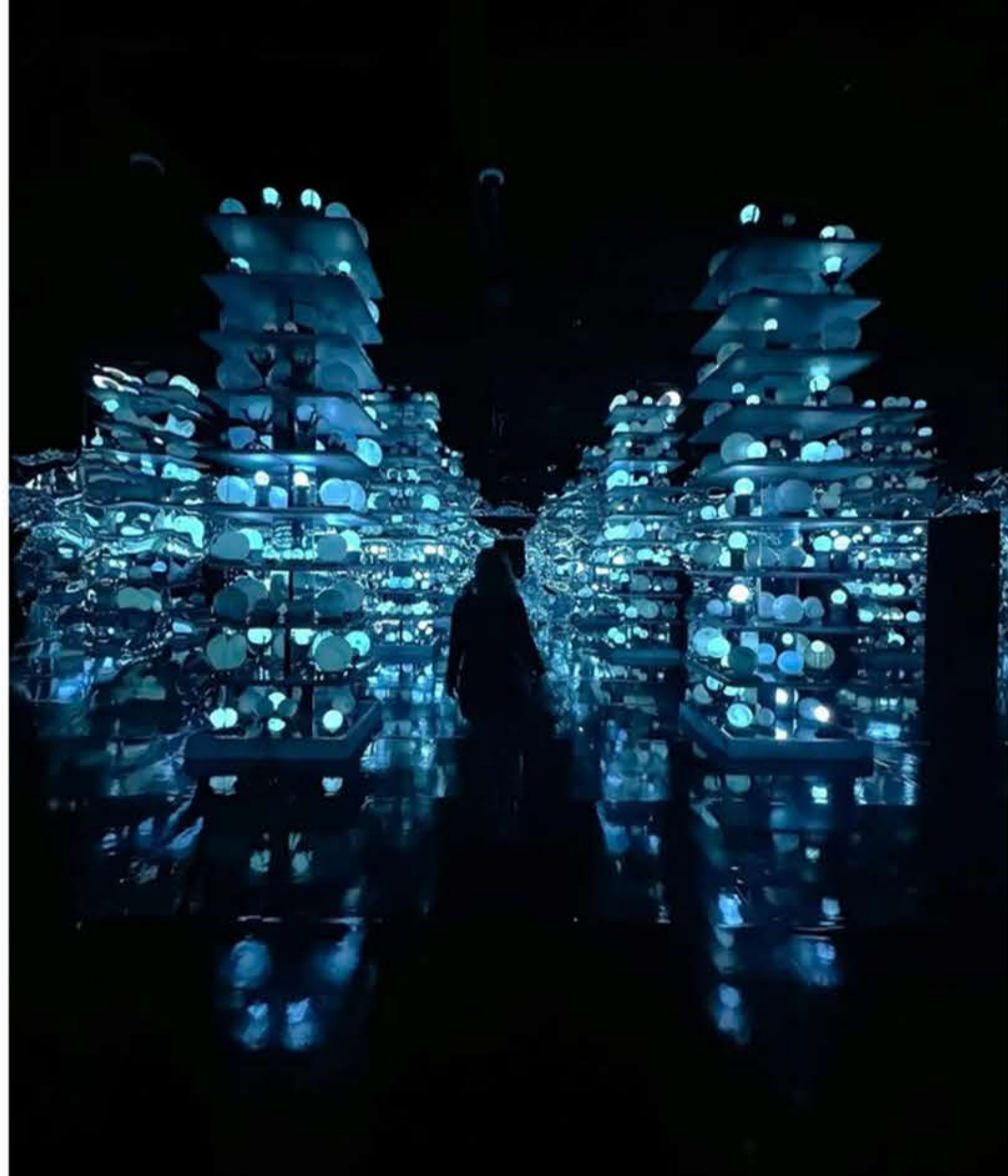

Fans eager to embark on this magical journey can join the exclusive waitlist on their website for priority access to pre-sale tickets and insider insights.

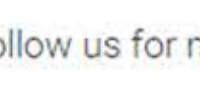
